Sailing Trip Suggestions for our Charter Clients starting in Cienfuegos, Cuba

4 Days Eastwards Cienfuegos – Cienfuegos

- 1st Day** Around 4 pm arrival at the charter base **Cienfuegos**. Boarding the catamaran, welcome, security briefing. Around 5 pm anchors aweigh and sailing eastwards. On board: cocktail at sunset. Around midnight arrival at **Cayo Blanco de Casilda**, anchoring and staying for the night.
- 2nd Day:** In the morning: sailing to **Trinidad**. Sightseeing in the historical **City of Trinidad**, lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon continuation of the journey to **Cayo Machos de Afuera**. The beach invites for a swim and the coral reef for a snorkeling excursion. Moreover, there are lizards and other animals to see. During the night anchoring in the bay.
- 3rd Day:** Sailing to **Zaza de Afuera**. During the trip relaxing and unwinding. In the local bay there is a special reef which is inhabited by a manifold of fishes that can be observed closely. Night spent anchored in the bay.
- 4th Day:** Sailing westwards to **Cayo Machos de Afuera**. Here, swimming and snorkeling in the coral reef, observing the native fauna. In the afternoon return to **Cienfuegos**, arrival at night. Overnight stay on board in the marina, check-out at 9 a.m. the following day.

5 Days Eastwards Cienfuegos – Cienfuegos

- 1st Day:** Embarkation at 16.00 hrs from Cienfuegos Yachtclub to navigate to a small beach **El Tamarindo** outside the Cienfuegos bay (approx. 2 hours), where it is very nice snorkeling, swimming and sunbathing on the beach.
- 2nd Day:** After breakfast navigation to **Cayo Blanco de Casilda** (approx. 6 hours) – lunch while navigating – a visit to this cayo (island) is possible where there is an open restaurant (ranchon) on the beach with various seafood dishes and local cocktails – also some iguanas can be observed in their natural environment. Then possible snorkeling in the coral reef.
- 3rd Day:** After breakfast navigation to **Cayo Macho** (approx. 2 hours) – visit of the island with several beaches and coral reefs – also here some iguanas and *jutias* in their natural element – lunch on board – and the afternoon at leisure of the clients.
- 4th Day:** After breakfast sailing to the marina of **Trinidad** (approx. 3 hours) – after a fast lunch in the boat visit of the historical center of Trinidad, a city built in 1512, classified as world monument with a lot of museums and places to visit – dinner in the famous *paladar* (private restaurant) *Sol y Son*, very well known in Trinidad for its excellent food and service.
- 5th Day:** Ca. 9.00 hrs a.m.: after breakfast sailing back to **Cienfuegos** (approx. 8 hours) with lunch while navigating – entering the marina Cienfuegos at about 17.00 hrs. Overnight-stay on board until 9:00 hrs a.m. of the next day, then check-out.

7 Days Eastwards Cienfuegos – Cienfuegos

- 1st Day:** Arrival and welcome at the Alboran-Bluesail Charter Base in **Cienfuegos**. Boarding and boat check-in. Dinner at a restaurant in the city. Enjoyment of nightlife in the city. Night spent at the boat in the charter base.
- 2nd Day:** In the morning departure towards the marina of **Trinidad**. Under way lunch and practicing navigational skills. Arrival at the marina of Trinidad (only possible during day-time, in order to be able to see the markings of the channel). Visit of the historical town center of Trinidad: due to its remarkable conservation status, the city, founded in 1512, was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. During the Spanish kingdom, Trinidad was a center of creed. During a tour through the lanes and streets you can indulge in Creole and Cuban cuisine, and of course enjoy the night-life with music and entertainment.
- 3rd Day:** Breakfast on board early in the morning and departure to **Cayo Blanco de Casilda**. During the trip guests may practice trolling and sailing. Later on, you can either enjoy a delicious seafood lunch at the Ranchón restaurant, the cay's restaurant, or have lunch on board. In the afternoon, guests can snorkel, sunbathe, swim or practice outdoor activities, and then, in the evening go into raptures over the sunset in the Caribbean. The restaurant closes in the afternoon so dinner will be taken on board. Night anchored off the cayo.
- 4th Day:** Breakfast on board, trip to **Cayos Machos de Afuera**, then visiting the island and its beach and coral reef, where guests can enjoy snorkeling and other outdoor activities. On the island, iguanas and *jutías* can be seen in their natural habitat. Lunch and dinner on board. Enjoyment of the sunset. Night anchored at the island.
- 5th Day:** Departure to **Zaza de Afuera**. During the trip guests may enjoy the trip and relax. In the bay of Zaza de Afuera there is a special reef with schools of many different fishes, which you may watch. During the night anchoring in the bay.
- 6th Day:** On the return trip visit of **Cayo Blanco de Casilda**. In the local bay you may enjoy the beach, sunbath, snorkel and explore the clime. Night anchored in the bay.
- 7th Day:** Return to **Cienfuegos** with sailing and enjoyment of the Caribbean. Arrival an the ALBORAN-BLUESAIL yacht charter base, overnight-stay on board until 9:00 hrs a.m. of the next day, then check-out.

4 Days Westwards Cienfuegos – Cienfuegos

- 1st Day** Around 4 pm arrival at the charter base **Cienfuegos**. Boarding the catamaran, welcome, security briefing. 5 pm anchors aweigh and sailing westwards. On board: cocktail at sunset. Around midnight arrival at **Cayo Sal**, anchoring and staying for the night.
- 2nd Day:** In the morning: swimming/snorkeling off the island, later continuation of the journey towards Cayo Largo. Around noon: arrival at the **Marina Cayo Largo**, check-in with the harbor master. Continuation of the journey to **Playa Sirena** (the magnificent beach of Cayo Largo), anchoring, lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon swimming, snorkeling, leisure time. In the evening enjoyment of nightlife in the local bars and clubs of the hotels. Overnight stay on board.
- 3rd Day:** Sailing westwards to **Cayo Iguana**, observation of the lizards that inhabit the island. Continuation of the journey to **Cayo Hijos de los Ballenatos**, a spectacular island with a large population of fishes. Afterwards visit of **Cayo Rico**, enjoying the natural channels and the gorgeous beach. In the afternoon return to the Marina of **Cayo Largo**, staying the night on board moored at the pier.
- 4th Day:** Sailing back eastwards, whistle stop at **Cayo Inglés** for swimming and snorkeling in the local coral atoll. Return to **Cienfuegos**. Arrival at the charter base around midnight. Overnight stay on board in the marina, check-out at 9 a.m. the next day.

3 Days Westwards Cienfuegos – Cayo Largo

- 1st Day** Around 4 pm arrival at the charter base **Cienfuegos**. Boarding the catamaran, welcome, security briefing. 5 pm anchors aweigh and sailing westwards. On board: cocktail at sunset. Around midnight arrival at **Cayo Sal**, anchoring and staying for the night.
- 2nd Day:** In the morning: swimming/snorkeling off the island, later continuation of the journey towards Cayo Largo. Around noon: arrival at the **Marina Cayo Largo**, check-in with the harbor master. Continuation of the journey to **Playa Sirena** (the magnificent beach of Cayo Largo), anchoring, lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon swimming, snorkeling, leisure time. In the evening enjoyment of nightlife in the local bars and clubs of the hotels. Overnight stay on board.
- 3rd Day:** Sailing westwards to **Cayo Iguana**, observation of the lizards that inhabit the island. Continuation of the journey to **Cayo Hijos de los Ballenatos**, a spectacular island with a large population of fishes. Afterwards visit of **Cayo Rico**, enjoying the natural channels and the gorgeous beach. In the afternoon return to the Marina of **Cayo Largo**, staying the night on board moored at the pier. Next morning 9.00 hrs: check-out of guests in the marina of **Cayo Largo**.

7 Days Westwards Cienfuegos – Cienfuegos

- 1st Day:** Arrival and welcome at the Alboran-Bluesail Charter Base in **Cienfuegos**. Boarding and boat check-in. Dinner at a restaurant in the city. Enjoyment of nightlife in the city. Night spent in the charter base on board of the yacht.
- 2nd Day:** Breakfast on board early in the morning and departure to **Cayo Guano del Este**. During the trip, guests can enjoy sailing and other water sports. Once on the cay, the boat can anchor in the 3 meter deep coral reefs to enjoy underwater activities like swimming and snorkeling. Night spent anchored in the cay.
- 3rd Day:** Breakfast on board and navigation to **Cayo Sal**. The island displays an extraordinarily beautiful coral reef with abundant sea life, including fish of different species and sizes, spiny lobsters and cat sharks, the ideal place for snorkeling. The cay has an inner salt-water lagoon forming a natural salt bed frequented by seagulls, ducks and other sea birds. In the northern area there is a nice anchoring place to spend the night.
- 4th Day:** Breakfast on board and departure to **Cayo Largo**. During the trip, guests can enjoy sailing and other sea sports. Once in the cay, visits can be made to **Sirena Beach**, one of the most beautiful beaches in the southern coast with unrivaled white sand for sunbathing and snorkeling. Lunch at a beach restaurant. Interesting places very close to Sirena Beach include the Capricho Beach, Women's Islands and natural swimming pools mainly known as 3rd, 4th and 5th channels. In the afternoon, visit of the **Cayo Largo Marina**, which provides services to yachts, and, if possible, visit of the turtle aquarium. At the marina, legal entry and exit arrangements can be made. Likewise, there are some restaurants, pubs and hotels for nighttime activities. Night anchored at the marina.
- 5th Day:** Departure to **Cayo Iguana**, habitat for a large number of these prehistoric animals where they can be watched in their natural environment. An auxiliary boat must be used to have access to this cay. Trip to **Cayo Hijos de los Ballenatos**, a spectacular island with a wide variety of fishes performing an amazing show around the boat while they are fed, turning the occasion into a delightful natural aquarium. Visit of **Cayo Rico** to enjoy the natural canals and the superb beach. In the evening, return to Sirena Beach to spend the night there.
- 6th Day:** Entering the **Cayo Largo Marina** for departure arrangements and a trip to Cayo Inglés. Lunch and sailing during the trip. In the cay, guests can snorkel in the beautiful coral reef. Later on, disembark to **Cayo Guano del Este** in a two-hour trip to spend the night there.
- 7th Day:** After an early breakfast, return trip to **Cienfuegos**. Arrival and landing at the Alboran-Bluesail base. Overnight-stay on board until 9:00 hrs a.m. of the next day, then check-out.

14 Days Westwards Cienfuegos – Cienfuegos

- 1st Day:** Arrival and welcome at the Alboran-Bluesail Charter Base in **Cienfuegos**. Boarding and boat check-in. Dinner at a restaurant in the city. Enjoyment of nightlife in the city. Night spent at the boat in the charter base on board the yacht.
- 2nd Day:** Breakfast on board early in the morning and departure to **Cayo Guano del Este**. During the trip, guests can enjoy sailing and other water sports. Once in the cay, the boat can anchor in the 3-meter deep coral reefs to enjoy underwater activities like swimming and snorkeling.
- 3rd Day:** Navigation to **Cayo Sal** during which guests can practice sailing and other water activities. Near the island is a beautiful coral atoll with an abundance of fishes, spiny lobsters and cat sharks. In the north is a suitable anchorage.
- 4th Day:** Departure to **Cayo Largo del Sur**. During the trip guests may do sailing and other water activities. Once at the island, visits can be made to Sirena Beach, one of the most beautiful beaches in the southern coast with unrivaled white sand for sunbathing and snorkeling. Lunch at a beach restaurant.
- 5th Day:** Morning spent on the beach of **Playa Sirena**. After lunch at one of the local restaurants you may visit one of the adjoining interesting places like the **Playa Capricho** on the **Islas Mujeres** or visit the turtle aquarium.
- 6th Day:** Trip to **Cayo Iguana**, habitat of a large number of these seemingly prehistoric animals where they can be watched in their natural environment. Continuation to **Cayo Hijos de los Ballenatos**, a spectacular island with a large population of fishes. Afterwards, visit of **Cayo Rico** to enjoy the natural channels and a splendid beach. In the afternoon return to Playa Sirena where the night is spent.
- 7th Day:** Trip to **Cayo Rosario**, visit of the rambling and pristine beach **Playa del Rosario**. Here you may watch the Iguanas as well. In the afternoon sailing to the channel of Rosario where you can spend the night safely protected from winds.
- 8th Day:** Visit of one of the **Cayo Cantiles** wildlife sanctuary's park rangers. Watch the island's animals like monkeys, iguanas and Hutias, in their natural habitat. Afterwards you may dive and snorkel in the outer reef of the island. Night spent at anchorage.
- 9th Day:** Departure to **Cayo Campos** to enjoy the island's beautiful beaches and snorkel in the coral reef. Also, some Cuban wildlife species can be found in their natural habitat, like the wild boar and the iguana. Night spent anchored off the island.

14 Days Westwards Cienfuegos – Cienfuegos (continued)

- 10th Day:** Return to **Cayo Rosario**. Enjoy the beach and discover the island's reef, with its beautiful colorful fishes. Spend the night anchored in the island's channel.
- 11th Day:** Further on your return trip you spend another day at **Cayo Largo**, at **Playa Sirena** enjoy the beach, the sun and activities in the fresh air. Night spent anchored off the beach.
- 12th Day:** Enjoy a day at **Playa Capricho** on the **Islas Mujeres** with its natural pools. The beautiful coral atoll of **Hijos de Ballenatos** invites you to swim. In the afternoon return to Playa Sirena to spend the night.
- 13th Day:** During the return trip stop at **Cayo Inglés**. Here you may snorkel in the coral reef, afterwards sail to **Cayo Guano del Este** and spend the night there.
- 14th Day:** After an early breakfast, return trip to **Cienfuegos**. Arrival at the Alboran-Bluesail base, overnight-stay on board until 9:00 hrs a.m. of the next day, then check-out.
