What do I do if I have some time to spend?

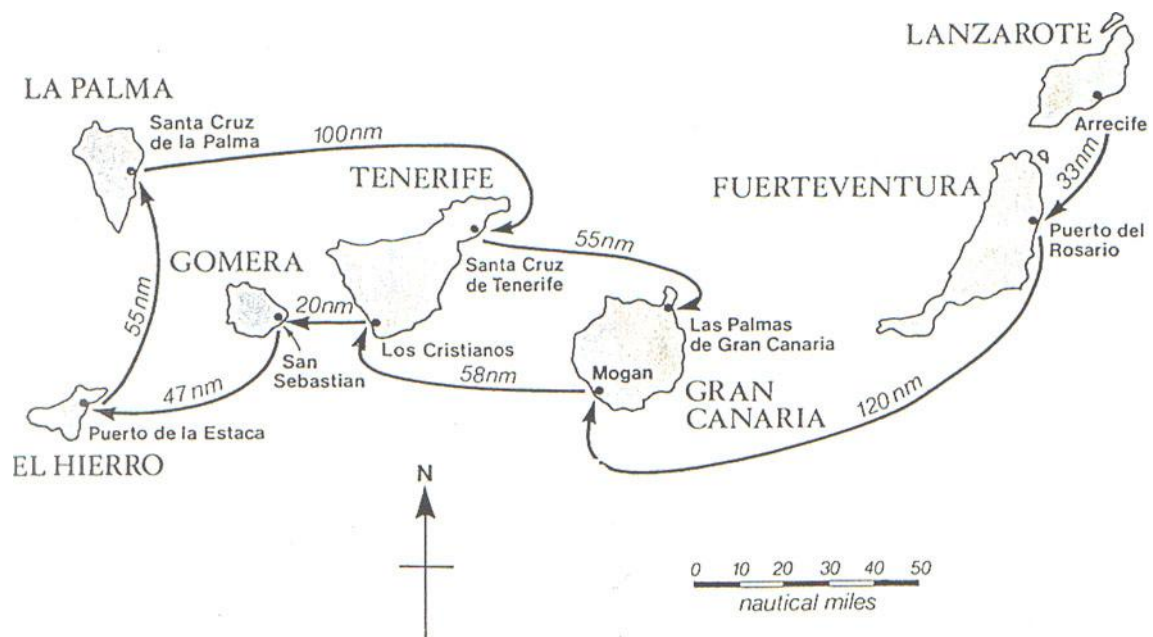
We suggest a [promenade of the Harbour](#) which is close to our base.

Information about the Canary Islands

The **Canary Islands** are an archipelago made up of seven major islands and various smaller islands. Situated in the Atlantic Ocean, northwest of the African coastline, the islands are located a little more than 4° from the Tropic of Cancer.

Its latitude and longitude positions are between $27^{\circ}37'N$ to $27^{\circ}29'N$ and $13^{\circ}29'W$ to $18^{\circ}10'W$ of Greenwich respectively.

This location gives the Canary Islands a subtropical and spring-like weather all year round.



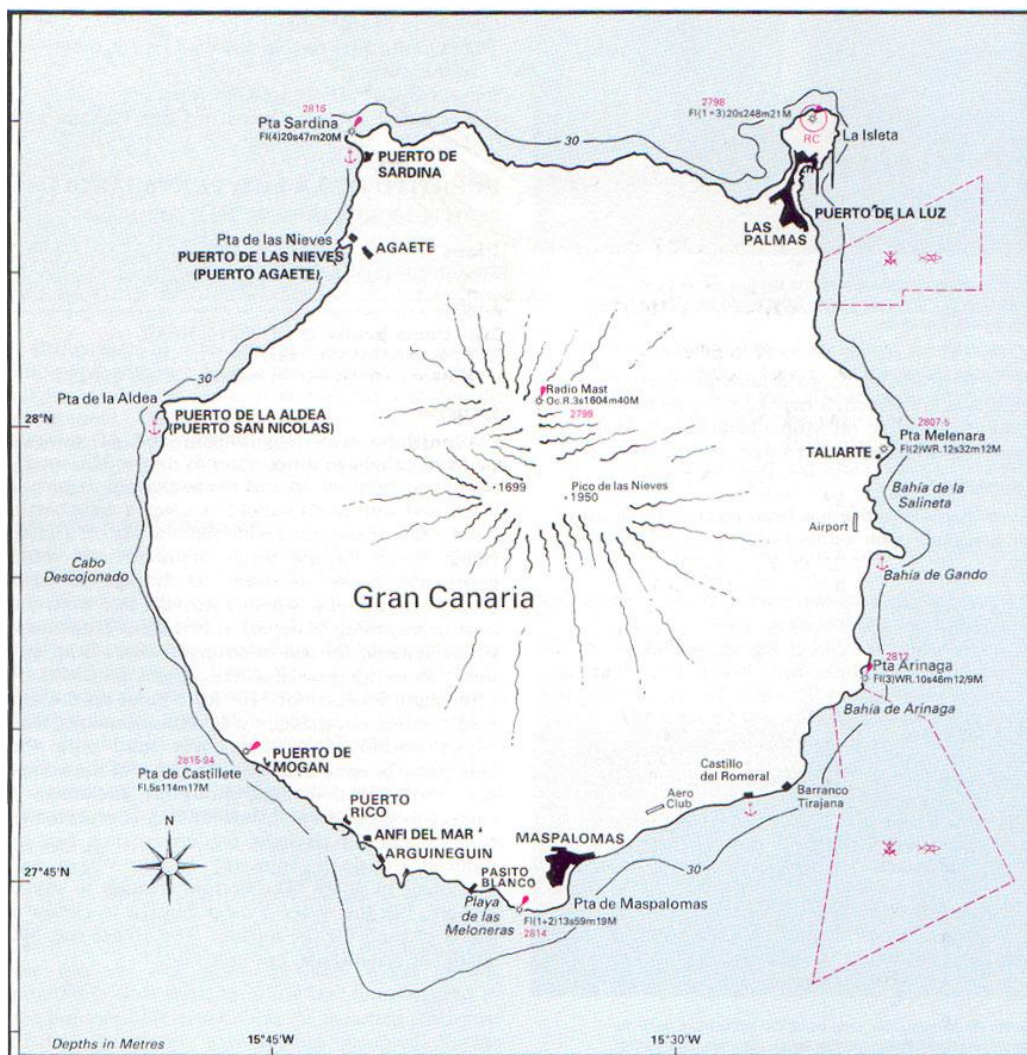
Gran Canary is situated on the 27th parallel and is, year round with spring-like temperatures owing to the "alisios" winds. With its high number of hours of sunshine, the average temperature in winter is at 20°C.

Gran Canary measures 49 kilometers in diameter with an area of 1.532 sq.km and 236 kilometers of coast line with numerous beaches.

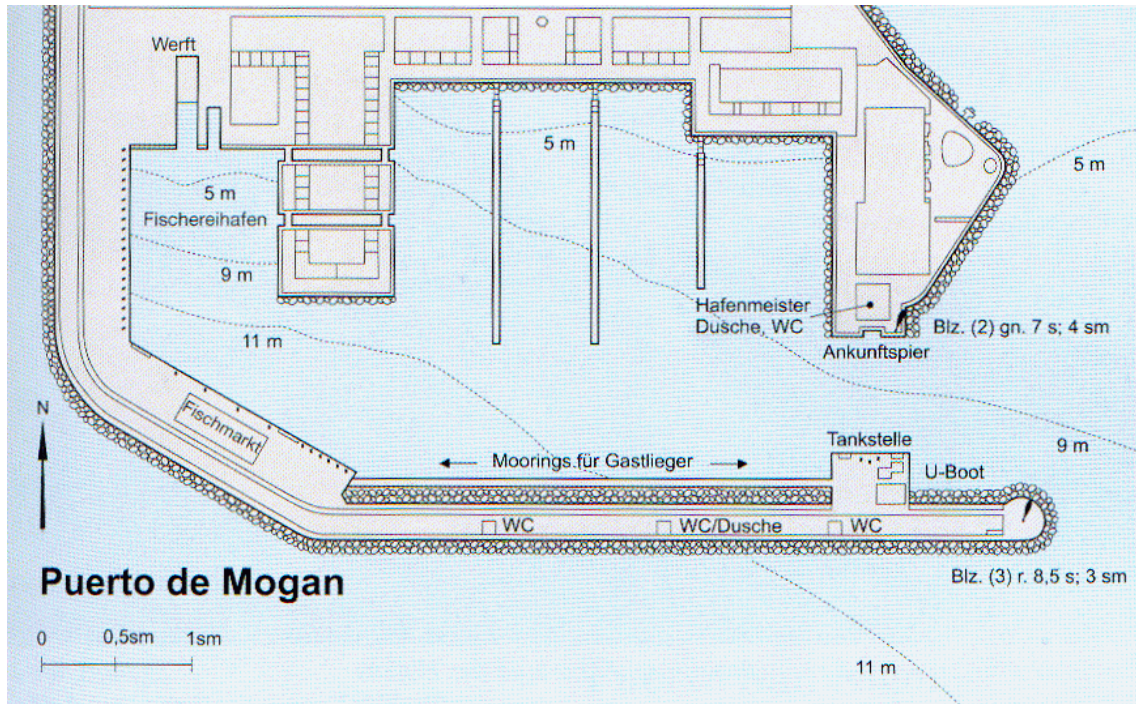
Its location is at an advantage point for those living in Europe for it only takes 3 to 5 hours in airplane for any European to arrive at this paradise.

The southern coast of the island is distinct for its fine golden sand beaches, emphasizing Playa del Ingles and Maspalomas where one can find the location of the Maspalomas Dunes, an authentic jewel of nature. The temperature of the clean and transparent waters fluctuates between 20 and 24 degrees during the whole year.

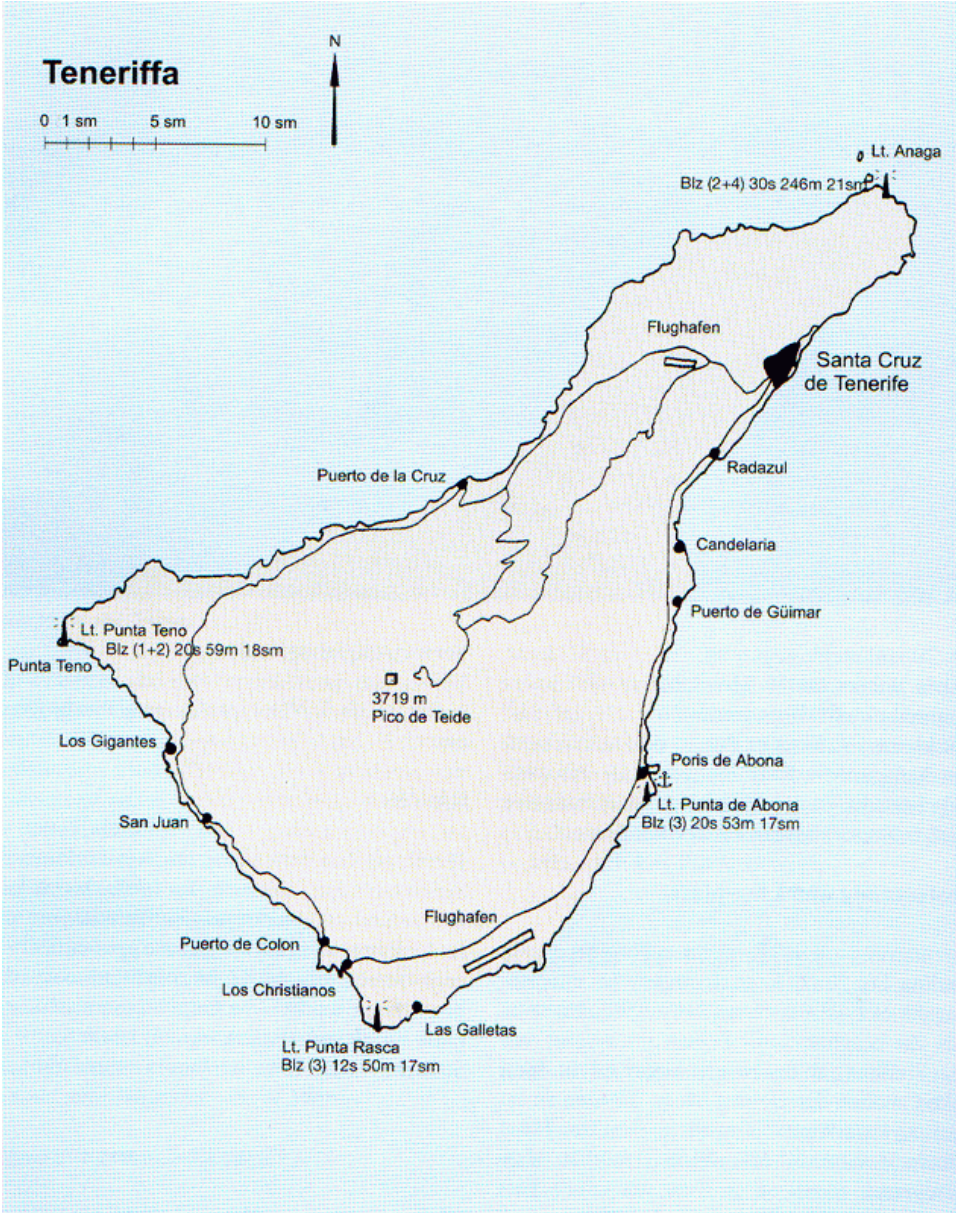
In contrast, the northern coasts of Gran Canary offers impressive volcanic rock cliffs where one discovers at the bottom of the cliffs small coves bathing in an intense sea of blue.



Puerto Mogan, located in the south of Gran Canaria, is strategically situated for the sailor who likes to make frequent stops for it is close to Puerto Rico, Arguineguin, Pasito Blanco and the Playa del Inglés. Once a sleepy little fishing village, Puerto Mogan has undergone uninterrupted developments and it has kept its village-like atmosphere with the original village surrounding the modern development. One can expect man-made canals running beside and under the whitewashed houses trimmed in bright colors surrounded by lush vegetation. The marina is extremely attractive with restaurants, stores and open air cafés on the waterfront giving the marina a lively atmosphere during both day and night. For the sun worshipper there is a black sand beach less than 10 minutes by foot from the marina where one can find crystal clear water enabling snorkellers to keep happy as well.



Tenerife is the largest island in the archipelago measuring a surface of 2.050 sq.km. The mountains that form the backbone of the island have direct bearing on the weather conditions all around. Thus there is a notable difference in temperature between the north and the south of the island. Its sun-trapped southwest coast is the ideal holiday spot for those who would like to enjoy the island's sun drenched beaches. In the northeastern part of the island, where it is cooler, there are fertile valleys where fruit and vegetables and a multitude of flowers grow in abundance.



Lanzarote, which is 1,000 miles from the Iberian Peninsula, is situated the furthest east of the seven major islands in the Canary Islands. Together with Fuerteventura and the smaller islands: Lobos, La Graciosa, Alegranza, Montaña Clara, Roque del Este and Roque del Oeste, Lanzarote has been nicknamed the "Islas Orientales".

Lanzarote has an area of 795 sq.km putting it in fourth place in respect to the surface area of the other major islands in the Canary Islands. The northeast coasts of Lanzarote are quite steep whereas. In the southwest one can count on a numerous amount of good beaches. The climate is mild and fluctuates between an average of 18 and 24 degrees during the whole year.



Puerto Calero, located in the southwestern part of Lanzarote, is probably the most beautiful port there is in the Canary Islands. Once on land Puerto Calero resembles more a private villa or a five star hotel with its colonial style architecture than a marina. The quaint marina offers restaurants and stores at competitive prices to every individual's tastes without the crowds of tourists. Puerto Calero offers the best service and is undoubtedly the safest place to leave a yacht unattended if one wishes to leave the island or visit the interior. Owing up to the saying "less is more" Lanzarote offers a unique theme of simplicity, whitewashed cubes of houses punctuated with doors and window in the same Lanzarote green. Due to the absolute beauty of this island Alboran feels very strongly that every one of their clients that sail with us in the Canary Islands should have the opportunity to discover the interior of the island.
