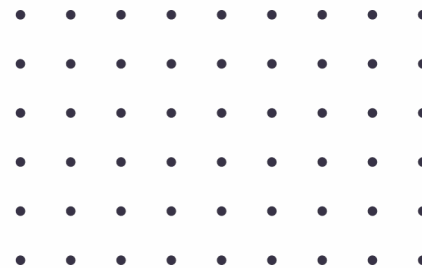

Sailing from Saint-Mandrier offers a multitude of possibilities for exploring the picturesque coves of the Côte d'Azur.

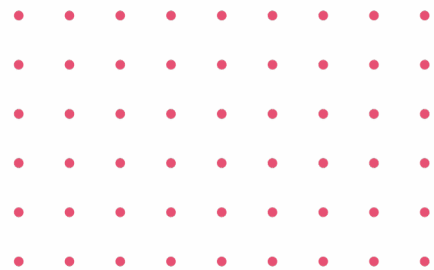

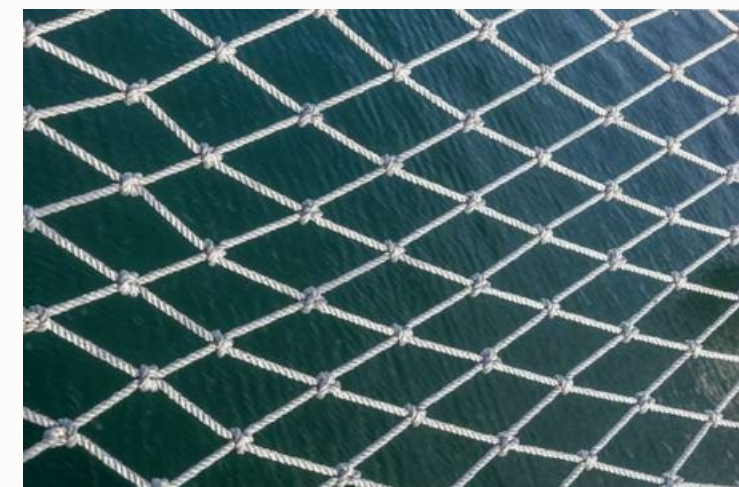
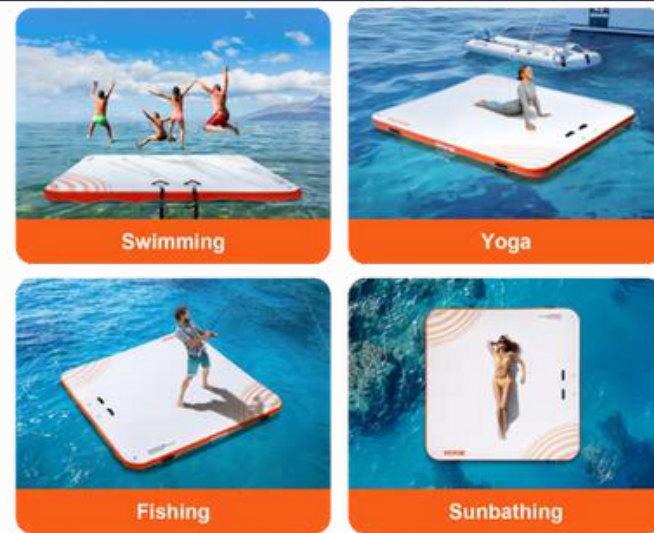
Kitchen

If you cause damage not covered by the rented boat's insurance and the rental company withholds your deposit, either partially or fully, you will be reimbursed. You are also covered for damages to the dinghy and its engine, propellers and drive units, as well as the rigging, mast, and sails. Additionally, you can add other insurance options to your coverage:

- Trip Cancellation Fees
- Skipper's Liability Insurance
- Emergency Medical Treatment Abroad
- Personal Accident Insurance

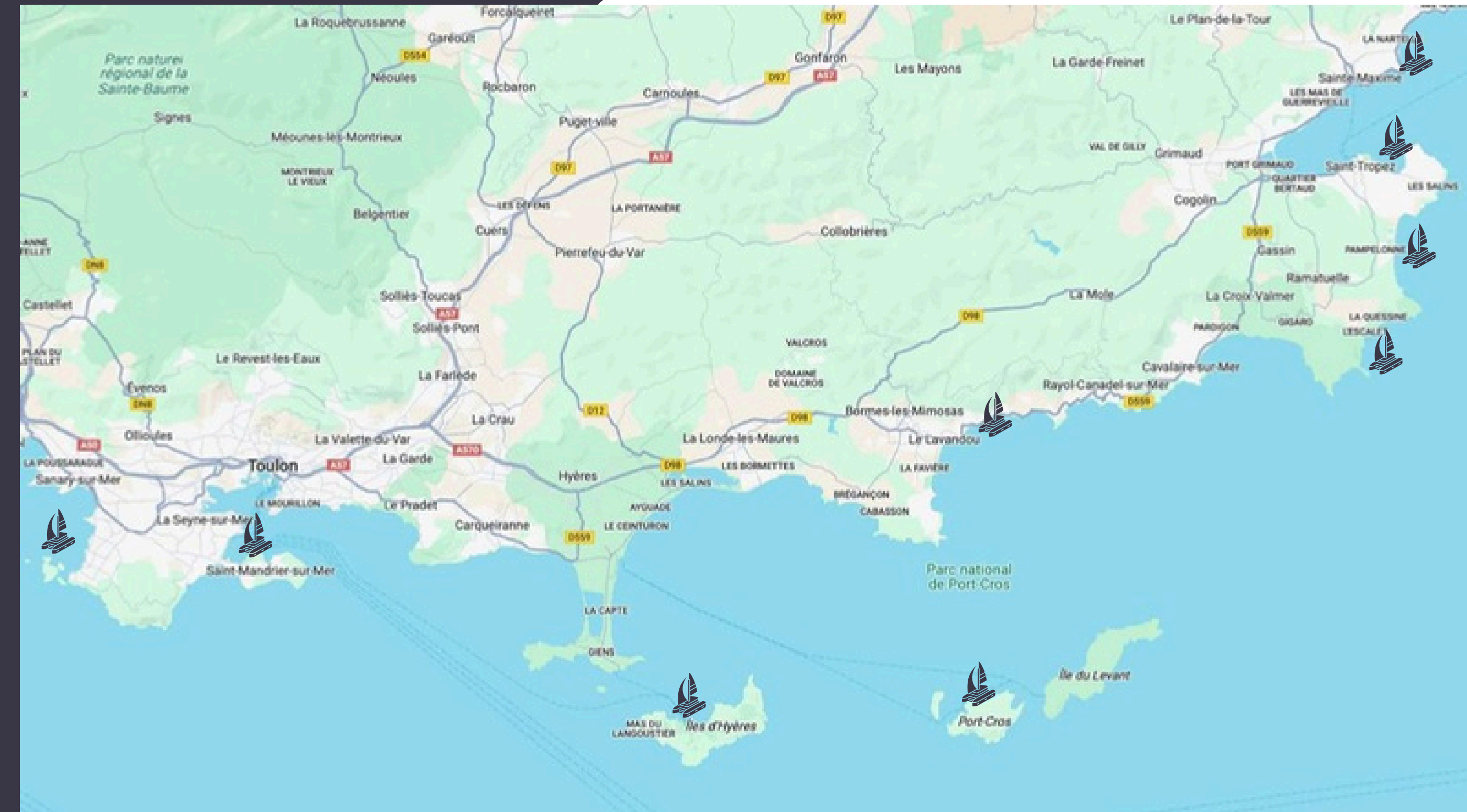

DAY 1

PORT PIN ROLLAND



Located near Saint-Mandrier-sur-Mer, Port Pin Rolland is a quiet private marina.

An ideal base for exploring the Côte d'Azur coastline and neighbouring islands.



At your disposal: free parking, a fuelling service, a taxi service, a restaurant bar in the marina, a shipshandler.

DAY 2

PORQUEROLLES

Distance from last location : 14 nm



Jewel of the Mediterranean: As well as its magnificent beaches bathed in turquoise waters, the island of Porquerolles has a contrasting coastline with forts and coves just waiting to be explored.

Plage d'Argent is a breathtaking white-sand beach that's a must-see, as is the 16th-century Fort de Sainte Agathe, where you can learn about the island's history while enjoying extraordinary views. With more than 54km of marked hiking and mountain biking trails, and some of the best diving in France, there's no shortage of adventure.



The absence of cars on the island makes cycling the ideal way to explore its beauty, but there are plenty of other activities, such as wine tasting at the local vineyards or foraging for coffee in the quaint cafés. Don't miss the Villa Carmignac's impressive collection of contemporary art.

DAY 3

LAVANDOU

Distance from last location : 11 nm



A beachfront paradise known for its natural grandeur and Mediterranean attractiveness that offers a calm and enchanting escape for everyone who visits.

Immerse yourself in the charm of Bormes-les-Mimosas, a delightful village celebrated for its medieval alleys, vibrant floral exhibitions, and panoramic views from the ancient castle remnants.



Discover the wonders of the Domaine du Rayol, an extraordinary Mediterranean garden showcasing a diverse collection of plant species from around the globe. Culminate your day with a sumptuous seafood feast at one of the waterfront restaurants, relishing the flavors that define the region.



DAY 4

CAP TAILLAT / PAMPELONNE BEACH

Distance from last location : 12 nm



Treasure of the peninsula of Saint Tropez. Cap Taillat is a sandy peninsula that juts into the Mediterranean Sea that features unspoiled beaches and picturesque hiking trails and is designated as a protected wildlife area. It is situated close to the historic village of Ramatuelle. To truly appreciate the magnificence of this locale, visit the Camarat Lighthouse. From its vantage point, you'll be rewarded with sweeping panoramic views of the entire Saint-Tropez peninsula and the vast expanse of the Mediterranean Sea.

Pampelonne Beach is a famous beach on the French Riviera, known for its golden sand and turquoise water, and is located near the glitzy Saint-Tropez. This 5km stretch of sand has been attracting A-listers, vacationers, and jet-setters for decades due to its magnetic allure and breathtaking scenery.



Relax on plush sunbeds and soak up some rays from the sun in the Mediterranean, or go for a swim in the clear waters that are ideal for water sports. Savour exquisite French cuisine and refreshing cocktails while basking in the sea breeze at one of the beach's many chic beach clubs or gourmet restaurants. Pampelonne Beach is a must-see for anyone visiting the Côte d'Azur, whether you're looking for a quiet place to relax in the sun or a taste of the high life.



DAY 5

SAINTE-MAXIME / SAINT-TROPEZ

Distance from last location : 5 nm



Sainte-Maxime is a charming village by the sea, bathed by the turquoise waters of the Mediterranean. Arriving by catamaran offers a breathtaking view, with verdant hills blending into the azure sea. As you sail along the coast between Saint-Tropez and Sainte-Maxime, you can spot golden beaches, secluded coves, and elegant villas overlooking the sea. The lively yet welcoming port of Sainte-Maxime is perfect for mooring, while the village center enchants with its picturesque streets, shaded terraces, and colorful markets.

It's a place where Provençal charm meets the relaxed luxury of the Riviera. Arriving in Saint-Tropez by catamaran from Pampelonne Beach is a magical experience. As you sail along the coast, the crystal-clear waters reveal fine sandy beaches, rugged cliffs, and intimate little coves. The catamaran glides smoothly, offering a breathtaking view of Saint-Tropez's silhouette emerging on the horizon, with its red-tiled rooftops and luxurious yachts anchored in the port.

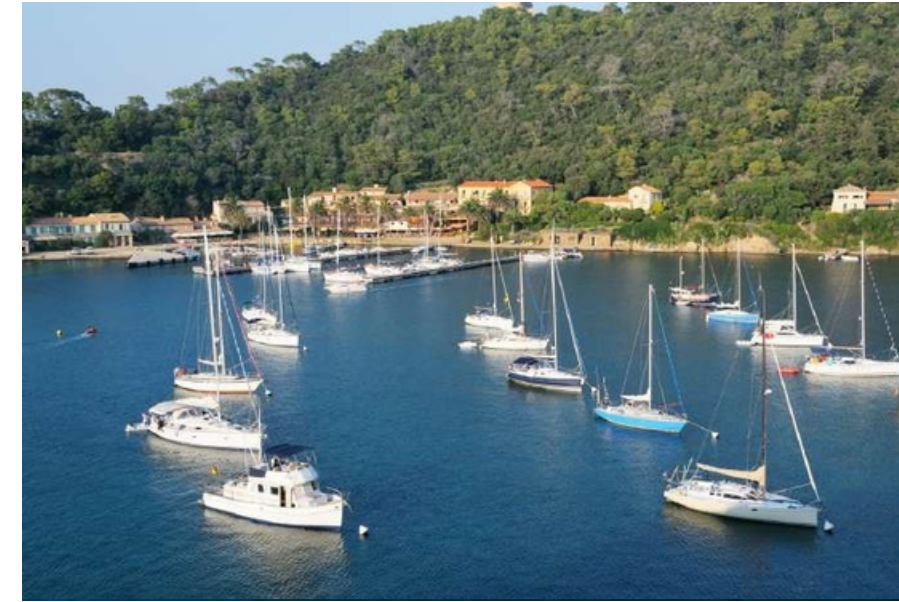

DAY 6

PORT CROS

Distance from last location : 19 nm

Classified as a National Park, the island captivates visitors with its hiking trails, wild beaches, and exceptional marine life, perfect for diving and snorkeling. Its historic forts, nestled in the heart of lush nature, add to the authentic charm of the place.



With no cars or excessive urbanization, Port-Cros is a true Mediterranean sanctuary, ideal for a nature-filled getaway.

DAY 7

ÎLE DES EMBIEZ / PORT PIN ROLLAND

Distance from last location : 27 nm



After sailing along the coast from Porquerolles, the boat heads towards Île des Embiez for a final anchorage before returning. As it approaches, the island reveals its wild coves, turquoise waters, and charming port lined with pine trees and softly colored houses. The atmosphere is peaceful, perfect for a last swim or a stroll along the natural trails.

With vineyards, small beaches, and preserved marine life, Les Embiez offer an idyllic stopover—a final timeless moment before setting sail back to the mainland. At the first light of day, your Bali glides silently towards the marina of Port Pin Rolland, bathed in the soft morning glow.



The air is fresh, and only the gentle lapping of the water and the distant cry of seagulls break the silence. As you approach the docks, the base team stands ready to welcome you for the check-out, offering assistance and guidance for mooring. This final moment at sea, embraced by the tranquility of the still-slumbering port, marks the end of a beautiful voyage before returning to solid ground.

Licences and permit

Let's get you out on the water! Whether you're in a car, on a boat, whizzing around on your jet ski or diving into the deep you might need a permit or licence. Don't miss out!

Personal devices

Bring all your chargers and an international adapter to keep your electronics juiced. Pro tip: if you bring a power board you can charge everything with one international adapter.

Camera

Your phone is great for quick shots, but if you need a long zoom lens, want something particularly cinematic or to shoot in low-light conditions, it's best to go for a specialized camera.

Books or Kindle

You'll have as many quiet, secluded moments as you want. Will you feel like a trashy airport novel or will you delve into one of the classics? Why not bring both, or a Kindle full?

Reading and sunglasses

Don't forget your shades and your reading glasses. That way you'll be able to enjoy the incredible views and a local magazine.

Sunscreen and hats

Be careful, the Mediterranean sun is very strong! Remember to protect yourself from morning to evening and after each swim !

Non-slip shoes Consider bringing plastic shoes, very useful to avoid slipping on the rocks.
